

Join S.A.F.E. Homes

A Program that Raises Awareness about Underage Drinking and Illegal Drug Use in Our Community

S.A.F.E. Homes families sign a pledge committing their homes to be alcohol free to minors.

Why Do We Need a S.A.F.E. Homes Program?

- Young people are constantly faced with pressures to use alcohol and other drugs.
- Alcohol is advertised and glamorized in the media and there are many social messages directed to youth encouraging the use of all kinds of substances.
- By refusing to take a stand, adults condone behavior that is unhealthy for children.

What Is the Pledge?

First, it is important to note that the "pledge" is a good faith promise, not a legal contract. By signing this pledge, you promise to:

- Provide adult supervision for large gatherings and/or parties in your home.
- Not serve alcohol to any guest under the age of 21 or permit underage drinking or illegal drug use in your home.
- Acknowledge that it is a criminal offense in New Jersey to serve alcohol to anyone who is under the legal age of 21.
- Have your name published in a directory. The directory indicates that you have:
1) signed the pledge *and* 2) agreed to be contacted by other parents.
